

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 117

RESOLVED by the Papago Council, that we hereby appoint

P. E. Chico,
Richard Hendricks,
John Ortiz,

to form a Committee to make arrangements for the securing of land in which the Tribal Herd may be kept and in which the Tribal Stock Activities may be carried on. The members of this committee shall be entitled to reimbursement for travel expenses incurred in attending meetings of this Committee and we authorize and request the Superintendent to pay the members of this committee at the same rate of pay as is received when attending regular meetings of the Papago Council, from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing Resolution was on June 1, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), Article V, and Section 3(a), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
