

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 115

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated one half of the proceeds of all the rock which has been sold from the San Xavier Reservation to date, said sum to be placed in an Individual Indian Money Account to the credit of the San Xavier District and to be used for the transaction of public business, meeting necessary expenses etc.,

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a) Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
