

RESOLUTION OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 139

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency or other officer in charge to retain the fund in "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-5, Papago Loan Board Expenses" which were appropriated for the fiscal year 1940 until it shall have been expended; and

RESOLVED FURTHER that we authorize the retaining of any remaining balances in the budget for the fiscal year 1940 in order that the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council may be enabled to secure additional office equipment for the Tribal office which will be located in the Community Building soon to be completed, and for which equipment there is at present no available storage space.

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1935, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
