

RESOLUTION OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 130

RESOLVED by the Papago Council, that we hereby endorse and approve the granting by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs of a license to Owen Johnson of Ti Junga, California to operate a restaurant and short order lunch room in the village of Sells on the Papago Reservation.

The foregoing Resolution was on August 3, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 9 for and 7 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (e) Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
