

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. - 122

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby extend a most cordial invitation, in behalf of the Papago Tribe, to Honorable John Collier, the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, to deliver the principal address at the ceremony dedicating the Papago Tribal Community House at Sells, Arizona, at 11:00 a.m., November 9, 1940; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we take this occasion to assure Mr. Collier of the very high regard and esteem in which he is held by all the Papago people, and to urge him to spend several days among us in order to better acquaint himself with the progress we have made as a result of his matchless leadership.

The foregoing resolution was on September 28, 1940 duly enacted by a vote of 17 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2, (d), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
