

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 123

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby extend a most cordial invitation, in behalf of the Papago Tribe, to Mr. Walter V. Woehlke, Assistant to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, to be present, and participate in the ceremonies dedicating the Papago Tribal Community House at Sells, Arizona at 11:00 a.m., November 9, 1940; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we take this occasion to express the gratitude of the Papago Tribe to Mr. Woehlke for his lively and sympathetic interests in the progress and advancement of our people.

The foregoing resolution was on September 28, 1940 duly enacted by a vote of 18 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2, (d), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
