
RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby extend a cordial invitation, in behalf of the Papago Tribe, to Mr. Xavier Vigeant, Director, Rehabilitation Division, Office of Indian Affairs, to attend the dedication of the Papago Tribal Community House at Sells, Arizona at 11:00 a.m., November 9, 1940; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we take this occasion to express the gratitude of the Papago Tribe to Mr. Vigeant for the part the Rehabilitation Division has played in making possible the construction of our Tribal Community House.


The foregoing resolution was on September 28, 1940 duly enacted by a vote of 8 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2, (d), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
