

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we grant, and there is hereby granted, a loan of \$3,000.00 from the fund, "I. I. M. Account No. P-4, Papago Loan Fund," to the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association, without interest, repayable in equal annual installments, and the Treasurer of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association is hereby directed to deposit with the Superintendent of Sells Agency from any of said Association funds in said Treasurer's possession, for credit to the fund, "I. I. M. Account No. P-4, Papago Loan Fund," the sum of \$500.00 on the first day of January, 1941, and a like amount on the first day of January each year thereafter until the full sum of \$3000.00 herein loan shall have been repaid; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the funds herein loan to the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association, shall be transferred to the fund "I. I. M. Account No. P-11, Papago Fair and Rodeo Association", and shall be expended under the direction of the Superintendent of the Sells Agency for the construction and completion of bleachers and sitting equipment first, and for all purposes incidental to the construction of facilities for holding the annual Papago Fair and Rodeo at Sells, Arizona; PROVIDED, that the location, type, and design of all structures erected from funds appropriated herein shall be subject to approval of the Board of Directors of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association.

The foregoing resolution was on September 23, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
