

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 128

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby commission Abe Pablo, Jose Narcho, Joe Vasquez as Special Indian Police, under the direction of the Chief of Police of the Sells Agency, during the period of the Papago Fair and Rodeo. These appointments are to be effective at the opening of November 8, 1940, and will terminate at the close of November 12, 1940, each appointee to be compensated at the rate of \$2.50 per day, payable from the fund "I.I.M. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund Papago Tribe."

The foregoing resolution was on September 28, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 19 for an 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) and (b), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
