

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 131

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to authority vested in him by Article V Section 6 of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, has, by letter dated October 1, 1940, rescinded Resolution No. 117, passed by the Papago Council on July 6, 1940, appropriating \$2,000.00 from the Papago Contributed Fund "for all purposes incidental to the construction of additional facilities for the holding of the annual Papago fair and rodeo"; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Interior objected to Resolution No. 117, not because of the \$2,000.00 appropriated for the construction of facilities for the annual Papago fair and rodeo, but because said Resolution No. 117 also provided that any balances remaining in "I.I.N. Account P-18, Community Building, 1939 Rehabilitation Trust Fund" should also be used, after construction of the Sells Papago Community Building is completed and furnished, on the construction of facilities at the Papago fair and rodeo; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Sells Agency has already expended the \$2,000.00 rescinded by Resolution No. 117, for the construction of an adobe wall and seating facilities in the rodeo arena;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council, that we hereby reappropriate the \$2,000.00 from "I.I.N. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe", which amount was included in the rescinded Resolution No. 117, and be it further resolved that we hereby approve the action of the Superintendent of Sells Agency in expending this sum for the purposes authorized by the said rescinded Resolution No. 117.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 2, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of \_\_\_\_\_ for an \_\_\_\_\_ against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
