

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 152

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby endorse rodent control measures within a radius of one mile of all farm lands and water storing and spreading structures on the Gila Bend, Papago, and San Xavier Indian Reservations.

The foregoing resolution was on November 2, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2, (d) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 13 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
