

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we approve the expenditure of available funds in the hands of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Board for the payment of the annual premium on the bond of the Treasurer of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Board.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 2, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
