

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 134

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency, or other officer in charge, to reimburse the members of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Board for travel expenses incurred in attending meetings of this Board held on Sept. 26, Oct. 4, 11, 18, 24, 29, Nov. 5, 6, 1940, ; and

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT THE MEMBERS OF THIS BOARD shall be paid at the same rate of pay as is received when attending regular meetings of the Papago Council, from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing Resolution was on November 2, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), Article V, and Section 5(a), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
