

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 137

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we authorize and request the Acting-Superintendent of Sells Agency to turn over to the Papago Arts and Crafts Board the sum of Ninety-Four (\$94.00) Dollars which was received from the sale of Sahuaro Cactus rib panels which were used in connection with the premiere showing of the motion picture "Arizona", in Tucson, Arizona., on November 15, and 16, 1940.

The foregoing Resolution was on Dec. 7, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 10 for and 5 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
