RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Whereas, there is a quantity of valuable building stone located on tribal land within the San Xavier Indian Reservation, and

Whereas, the University of Arizona is desirous of purchasing 300 yds of this building stone, and

Whereas, it is deemed essential that we appoint someone to represent us in the inspection and sale of building stone from the tribal lands of the San Xavier Reservation.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby appoint the Ditch Rider of the San Kavier Water Users' Association as our building stone agent on the San Kavier Reservation who will perform the following duties:

- 1. Be available to show the buyers of building stone the location of same.
- 2. To sell building stone on the ground, for cash on delivery, at the rate of \$1.00 per cubic yard.
- 3. All monies collected for the sale of building stone shall be promptly remitted to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council, together with a statement showing the name of the purchaser, date and quantity of stone sold, and total amount of remittance.

The Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council shall as of the first day of the month following the receipt of the remittance for the sale of building stone, draw a check in favor of the said Ditch Rider of the San Kavier Water Users' Association in the amount of not to exceed 20¢ per cubic yard for all building stone sold by the said Ditch Rider for the account of the Council, during the preceding month.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 5, (h), Article V of the constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (4 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of itsapproval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Papago Tribe.
