Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Salls Agency or other officer in charge, to reimburse the members of the Health Committee

Frank Rios Abe Fablo Espirito Adams

for travel expense incurred in attending a meeting with the Supervisor of Health education held at Sells, Arizona on January 3, 1940, and a meeting of the Health Staff of Sells Agency, held at Sells, Arizona on January 4, 1940, at the same rate of pay received when attending regular meetings of the Council, from the fund "I. I. M. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing resolution was on February 3, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
