

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 97

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we approve "Scheme B" of the floor plan of the proposed community building transmitted to the Superintendent of Sells Agency by Indian Office letter dated February 13, 1940, file reference Ind. Rehab. 76080, excepting that the plan of the Office located in the Arts and Crafts wing be changed to eliminate the entrances to same as depicted in "Scheme B2 dated February 2, 1940, and entrances connecting said office with the display room and the storage room be substituted therefor; and

Be It Further Resolved, that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated from the fund "I. I. E. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe", not to exceed Five thousand dollars (\$5,000), to be expended under the direction of the Superintendent of Sells Agency, for all purposes incidental to, and including the construction of the proposed community building approved in the first paragraph hereof; Provided, that no funds appropriated herein may be expended until the sum of Ten thousand (\$10,000) shall have been allotted and made available for expenditure for the construction of the said proposed community building, by the Office of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 2, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 10 for and 6 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 13, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 1461 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
