RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 69

Resolved by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe" the sum of Five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) to be expended under the direction of the Superintendent of Sells Agency for all purposes incidental to the construction and equipment of a Community Building at Sells Agency, Arizona; it being understood and expressly provided that the said Community Building shall be financed as follows:

Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) as appropriated herein,

Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to be supplied by the Rehabilitation Division, Office of Indian Affairs,

Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) to be supplied by the Indian Division C. C.; and

Be it further Resolved that we hereby authorize the said Superintendent to expend such additional amounts from the fund "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe" as may be required to complete the construction and furnishing of the said Community Building over and above the Twenty-three thousand dollars estimated cost as outlined herein.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 10 for and 2 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
