RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we grant, and there is hereby granted, a loan of One thousand eight hundred and fifty (\$1,850.00) Dollars from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-4, Papago Loan Fund," to the Tribal Breeding Herd Committee, without interest, payable according to a plan worked out by the Extension Agent of Sells Agency and attached to this resolution.

PROVIDED that this appropriation shall be deposited in an I. I. M. Account at Sells Agency and shall be expended under the direction of the Extension Agent subject to the approval of the Superintendent for the purpose of buying registered stock from Indians and retaining this stock on the Papago Reservation in the tribal herd.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1942 duly enacted by a vote of 15 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (c), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe.
