

RESOLUTION OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL.

No. 169

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars from the fund, "I. I. N. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe" for defraying of the cost of travel in the registration of Papago Indians living off the reservations; and,

PROVIDED and when and if funds are made available for the refund of this expenditure this amount shall be returned to the fund, "I. I. N. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1942, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
