

RESOLUTION OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 170

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency, or other officer in charge, to reimburse each officer and delegate of the Papago Council for travel expense incurred in coming to Sells, Arizona on June 13, 1942 for the purpose of attending a regular meeting of the Papago Council which was not held due to the fact that there was not a quorum present.

PROVIDED that the delegates shall be paid at the regular rates which they receive for attending meetings of the Papago Council.


PROVIDED FURTHER that the amounts shall be paid from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe", as follows:



The foregoing resolution was on June 27, 1942, duly enacted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.


