RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we authorize and there is hereby authorized, the use of one beef for a barbecus which will be served in connection with the festivities in observence of the Fourth of July Celebration which will be held at Sells, Arizona., on July 4, 1942.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 27, 1942, duly enacted by a vote of 11 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (k), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 954). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Salls Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and Py-laws of the Papago Tribe.
