

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 173

RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that we hereby authorize and request the Chairman of the Papago Council to renew the tribal permits covering the occupancy of tribal lands for business purposes by the following licensed Indian Traders, for the period beginning July 1, 1942 and ending June 30, 1943; and


PROVIDED that the rates shall be doubled those set forth in the permits granted the said licensed traders for the period beginning July 1, 1938 and ending June 30, 1939, said permits having been approved by the Department of the Interior under date of March 16, 1938.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 27, 1942, duly enacted by a vote of 11 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (c), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 6 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
