

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RESOLVED by the Papago Council, that, we hereby adopt the following budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1943.

1. For per diem expenses of delegates and officers of the Papago Council for attendance at regular meetings, special meetings and meetings at which there is a lack of a quorum, payable from the Tribal fund "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-84, Papago Contributed Fund", at the following rates:

2. Stationary, office supplies & equipment, telephone & telegraph tolls, postage, etc., payable from "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund".

3. Travel expenses, Chairman of the Papago Council, for attendance at Indian Service Conferences. Reimbursement for travel expenses incurred under this authority to be in conformity with the Standard Travel Regulations of the United States Government, payable from the fund, "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund".

4. Salary, Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council, payable from the fund "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund".

\$1,500.00

5. Expenses of Loan Board, payable from "I.I.M. Acct. P-4, Papago Loan Fund,":

A. Per diem of members attending Loan Board meetings, (12 meetings at .9.00 each)	\$108.00	
B. Per diem of members attending special meetings of the Loan Board. (6 meetings at \$18.00 each)	\$108.00	
C. Miscellaneous, (Office supplies, equipment, etc.)	\$200.00	\$416.00

6. Salary for Caretaker of the Papago Tribal Community Building, payable from "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund",

\$720.00

7. Tribal Emergency Fund for fiscal year 1943; for expenses for emergencies and for which no other Tribal funds have been made available, to be expended under duly enacted Resolutions; payable from the account "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3 Papago General Fund". A separate account is to be set up for this item.

\$500.00

8. Fund for paying committees of the Papago Council for travel expenses incurred in attending meetings. Members to be paid at the same rate as is received for attending regular meetings of the Council. This fund to be payable from "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund".

Total Budget items payable from the fund "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund";

Total Budget items payable from the fund "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-4, Papago Loan Fund";

Total Budget items payable from the fund "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-84, Papago Contributed Fund";

RESOLVED FURTHER that the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council in addition to performing the combined duties of Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council as prescribed by Sections 3 and 4, of Article 1 of the By-laws of the Papago Tribe, shall also perform the duties of Clerk of the Sells Court of Indian Offenses, and Clerk of the Loan Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, or other officer in charge, to pay to the order of the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council, the sum of \$5,616.00 from the respective funds, "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3"; "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-4"; and "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-84" as totaled in the budget items of this resolution, for deposit under the same conditions as those of the previous fiscal year.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 6, 1943 duly enacted by a vote of 12 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 under the provisions of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior under Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
