

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 175

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated from the fund, "I. I. E. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund," the sum of Eight Hundred-Fifty-Seven (\$ 857.00) Dollars which is to be transferred to "I. I. E. Acct. No. T-27" for the operation of the Tribal Herd until July 1, 1943; and

PROVIDED that this appropriation shall be expended under the direction and supervision of the Extension Agent of Sells Agency with the approval of the Superintendent for operation the Tribal Herd of the Papago Reservations.



The foregoing Resolution was on August 1, 1942, duly enacted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 934). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe.
