

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars from the fund, "I. I. E. Acct. No. P-24, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe" to be used in the eradication of mesquite trees in the Alahambra Valley of the Papago Reservation, Arizona,

PROVIDED that this sum shall be set up in an Individual Indian Money account and that it shall be expended under the direction of the Department of Forestry of the Sells Agency with the approval of the Superintendent.

PROVIDED FURTHER that one half of the proceeds from the sale of the wood cut on this land shall be given to Mrs. Isabel Lejero whose home is acknowledged established on this land. Other proceeds which shall be realized from this work shall be deposited to the credit of the Tribe in "I. I. E. Acct. No. P-24, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing Resolution was on September 5, 1942 duly enacted by a vote of 16 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 924). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe.
