

RESOLUTION OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 177

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated the sum of Three-Hundred and Sixty (\$360.00) Dollars from the fund "I. I. M. Acct. No. F-24, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe" for the purpose of buying prisoners rations for the Sells Court of Indian Offenses and for the paying of Associate Judges of the Court.

PROVIDED that this sum shall be deposited in "I. I. M. Acct. No. C-3, Court Funds, Papago Tribe" and shall be expended under the direction of the Superintendent of Sells Agency.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 5, 1942, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 924). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe.
