

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appoint and there is hereby appointed the following three men:

Peter Blaine
Jones Narcho, Jr.,
Henry Throssell

to form a committee to work on the immigration problems of the Papago Indians on the Papago Reservations and to cooperate with the authorities of Mexico in behalf of those Papagos who have alternately lived in the United States of America and in Mexico.

PROVIDED that this committee shall work closely with the Superintendent of Sells Agency in the solution of the various problems which may come up in connection with these immigration laws and regulations on the Papago Reservation, and;

PROVIDED FURTHER that the members of this committee shall be compensated for travel expense in accordance with Resolution No. 147 enacted by the Council under date of April 16, 1941.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 5, 1942 duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2(e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency.
