

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that whereas the following three men:

C. J. McElroy, Tucson, Arizona.,
Dr. John B. King, Tucson, Arizona.,
Robert H. Coleman, Tucson, Arizona.,

have all shown by sincere effort and cooperation that they are very much interested in the advancement and the success of the Papagos on the Gila Bend, Sells, and San Xavier Reservations; and

WHEREAS it is felt by the Papago Council that the Indians of the Papago Reservation have a great deal for which these men may be thanked;

THEREFORE these three men shall be issued complimentary hunting permits on the Papago reservations to exist until such a time as they shall be revoked by the Papago Council.


PROVIDED that the permit for Mr. R. H. Coleman shall be for hunting mountain lions and the other two shall be the regular hunting permits.


The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1942, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1935, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe.
