RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency, or other officer in charge, to reimburse from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. F-3, Papago General Fund," the members of the Papago Council for travel expense incurred in coming to Sells to attend a meeting of the Council which could not be held because there was not a quorum present!XXXX on July 11, 1942; and

PROVIDED further that we authorize and request the Superint indent of Sells Agency, or other officer charge, to reimburse the members of the Papago Council for travel expense incurred in coming to Sells to attend a special meeting of the Council on September 12, 1942 from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing Resolution was on September 12, 1942, duly exacted by a vote of 15 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe.
