

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Agency

RESOLVED by the Papago Council, that the deduction of not less than 10%, nor more than \$5.00 from the salaries and wages of members of the Papago Tribe, now being made by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency on the Government payrolls pursuant to the Stipulation of the Papago Tribe of May 18, 1935, be immediately discontinued; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any deductions made by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency pursuant to the Stipulation of May 18, 1935, from the salaries and wages of Papago Indians on any payroll for the months of July, August, September, October, November and December 1942, be refunded to the respective individuals, from the fund, "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-84".

The foregoing Resolution was on January 16, 1943, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
