RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 188

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated from the fund, "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund," the sum of Eight Hundred-Fifty-Seven (\$857.00) Dollars, which is to be transferred to "I.I.M. Acct. No. T-27", for the operation of the Tribal Herd until July 1, 1943; and

PROVIDED that this appropriation shall be expended under the direction and supervision of the Extension Agent of the Sells Agency with the approval of the Superintendent, for operation of the Tribal Herd of the Papago Reservations;

AND PROVIDED FURTHER, that the unexpended balance remaining on July 1, 1943 may be continued to be expended after July 1,1943 under such authority as the Papago Council may delegate by a duly enacted Resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 16, 1943, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act. of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
