

RESOLUTION OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 190

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we authorize Jones Marcho, Jr. to sign checks for the travel expenses of the Council members attending the regular meeting of the Council on February 6, 1943.

And, be it further RESOLVED that we authorize Jones Marcho, Jr. to sign a check for the balance of the sum in the Papago checking account in the Southern Arizona Bank and Trust Co., Tucson, Arizona, that said balance may be withdrawn from said bank and deposited with the Agency Office.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 6, 1943, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 2 (f), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of passage.
