

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 191

WHEREAS, Jones Narcho, Jr., Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council, admitted in writing that he embezzled and appropriated to his own use funds belonging to the Papago Loan Board of the Papago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the sum embezzled was in excess of \$6000.00; and

WHEREAS, there can be no surety that said funds would be recovered if Jones Narcho, Jr. were allowed to work and repay the sum in monthly allotments; and

WHEREAS, neither the U.S.I.S. nor the Tribe wish to employ said Mr. Narcho further so that he could make this repayment; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Narcho was bonded for the sum of \$5000.00 with the Maryland Casualty Insurance Co.

Therefore, be it RESOLVED that the case of Jones Narcho, Jr. be turned over to the Maryland Casualty Insurance Co. by the Papago Council with the demand for the payment of the bond, in the penal sum of \$5000.00.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 6, 1943, duly enacted by a vote of 8 for, and 2 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 2 (m), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
