RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby supropriated the sum of \$ 33.85 from the fund, "I.I.M. P-3, Papago General Fund" for the payment of travel expenses for

of the Papago Council who was delegated and authorized by this resolution to travel with the U.S.I.S. auditors in checking the loan accounts of the Papago Indians on the Reservation and the accounts of the Papagos who are employed off the reservation at the present time.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 6, 1943, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (43 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sella Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe.
