RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 193

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$ 50.00 from the fund, "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3 Papago General Fund," for use in travel expenses of

Mr. Henry Throssell, Chairman
Mr. Manuel Puella, Vice-Chairman

of the Papago Council in attending a conference to be held in Hermosillo, Sonora, MEXICO for the purpose of discussing land problems of the Papagos in Arizona and Sonora, Mexico.

PROVIDED that these expenses shall be paid for at the rate of Five (\$5.00) Dollars per day for a total of five days, amounting to a sum of \$ 25.00 for each of the delegates.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 6, 1943, duly enacted by a vote of ~~12~~ 12 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe.
