

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 194

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$500.00 from the fund, "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3 Papago General Fund," for the salary of the newly appointed Tribal Secretary-Treasurer George Throssell, the salary to be paid to him at the rate of \$100.00 per month for the period February 1, 1943 to June 30, 1943.

PROVIDED that, the salary shall be paid to George Throssell under this Resolution only to the time that the Tribal fiscal year 1943 budget has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior, after which his salary, at the same rate of \$100.00 per month, shall then be paid from the amount set up in the fiscal year 1943 budget, and not to extend beyond June 30, 1943;

AND PROVIDED FURTHER, that his salary shall in the future be included in and paid from funds duly appropriated by the Council in future annual budgets.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 6, 1943, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for, and 0, against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section (3a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, under the provisions of Section 6, Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe.
