## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby confirm the right of the War Department of the United States of America to the use of those sites doesed suitable for the establishment of practice tembing sites on tribal lands of the Cila Bend, Sells, And San Kavier Reservations; and

RESULVED that these sections shall, if possible, be fenced in so that the stock of the Indians on the reservations shall be protected; and

PROVIDED FURTHER that all arrangements shall be made by the Superint--endent of the Sells Agency, including the determination and acceptance of a satisfactory annual routel foe, in order that all may be done to give the Etmost ecoporation of the Papago Tribe to the United States.

The foregoing resolution was on threh 6,1943, duly enacted by a vote of ls for and O against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(d). Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribo ratified by the Tribe on December 12,1956, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Juneary 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16, of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Atat. 984). Said resolution to effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sella Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuent to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
