RESOLVED by the Papago Council that reimbursement of travel expensus in the amount of \$20.00 be made to:

Mr. Richard Hendricks,

of the Papago Council who was delegated and authorized to travel with the U.S.I.S. auditors in checking the loan accounts of Papago Indians on the reservation and Papago Indians employed off the reservation.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this reimbursement be made from Item 7, Tribal Emergency Fund, of the fiscal year 1943 Tribal Budget, Resolution No.174.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 6, 1943, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for, and O against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1935, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937, under the provisions of Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Scuperintendent of the Sells Agency; no further action being necessary by the Secretary of the Interior, since Resolution 174 had previous approval by the Secretary.
