

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 197

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$8.00 from Item 7, Tribal Emergency Fund, of the fiscal year 1943 Tribal Budget, Resolution No. 174 for the payment of advertisement in the Escuela School Annual. The above stated amount to be made payable to the Escuela School Annual.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 6, 1943, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, under the provisions of Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency; no further action being necessary by the Secretary of the Interior, since Resolution 174 had previous approval by the Secretary.
