

RESOLVED by the Papago Council, that we hereby adopt the following budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1944:

1. For travel expenses of delegates and officers of the Papago Council for attendance at regular meetings, special meetings, and meetings at which there is a lack of a quorum, payable from the Tribal Fund I.I.M. Acct. P-3, Papago General Fund, at the following rates:

PROVIDED that, if it is determined that any delegate incurs a greater expense in attending meetings under this item, the difference between the authorized per diem and his actual expense shall be paid to him from Item No. 8, Emergency Fund.

2. Stationary, office supplies & equipment, telephone & telegraph tolls, postage, etc., payable from "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund,"

\$150.00

3. Salary, Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council, payable from the fund "I. I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund". Salary payable at the rate of \$100.00 per month, for fiscal year.

\$1,200.00

4. Salary For Caretaker of the Papago Tribal Community Building, at the rate of \$60.00 per month, for the fiscal year. Payable from the "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund."

\$720.00

5. Payment of travel expenses of Council Committees, during the fiscal year, in attending necessary meetings. Committee members to be paid travel expenses at the same rate as for regular meetings described in item 1; to be payable from "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund."

\$500.00

- 6. Travel expenses at the rate of \$5.00 per day, of the Chairman of the Council in attending necessary meetings and conferences with Agencies or other units than the Council Committee meetings; including such meetings as may be necessary in the United States, or in Mexico during the fiscal year; and such other trips as may be necessary in the performance of his duty as Chairman of the Council. Payable from "I.I.M. Acct. P-3, Papago General Fund." \$200.00

- 7. Fund for the care and maintenance of the Tribal Herd, including wages of a herder, materials and supplies and equipment necessary incident thereto during the fiscal year; to be expended under the supervision of the Superintendent or other officer in charge of the Sells Agency; provided that a statement be furnished by the Superintendent or other officer in charge in the form of a program of expenditures and receipts; an inventory of the Herd; and a narrative report similar to the one submitted under date of June 26, 1942 for the previous fiscal year.
 PROVIDED, that receipts under this item shall be available for immediate expenditure during the fiscal year.
 Payable from "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund," to be transferred to "I.I.M. Acct. T-27, Tribal Herd." \$900.00

- 8. Tribal Emergency Fund for the fiscal year 1944; for expenses for emergencies and contingencies and for which no tribal funds have been made available, to be expended under Resolution by the Council. Payable from "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago General Fund." \$3,000.00

- Total amount to be payable from I.I.M. Acct. No. P-3. \$7,870.00

The foregoing Resolution was on this 3d day of April 1943, duly enacted by the vote of 14 for, and 0 against by the Papago Council, under the provisions of Section 3, Article V, and Section 4, Article VIII, of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1924, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject only to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Papago Tribe.
