

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 199

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that reimbursement of extra travel expenses in the amount of \$3.00 be made to:

Mr. Juan Harvey

of the Papago Council who is now living in Tucson and thereby incurred a greater expense in attending the regular Council meeting held on April 3, 1943.

RESOLVE FURTHER, that this reimbursement be made from Item 7, Tribal Emergency Fund, of the fiscal year 1943 Tribal Budget, Resolution No. 174.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 3, 1943, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, under the provisions of Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency; no further action being necessary by the Secretary of the Interior, since Resolution 174 had previous approval by the Secretary.
