

RESOLUTION OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 200

WHEREAS it is agreed that the Tribal Herd was in dire need of stock-water during the past fall; and

WHEREAS the King Investment Company agreed to the use of water from their well to alleviate the water shortage; and -

WHEREAS there is a tract of approximately 320 acres of land in the Alhambra Valley having a carrying capacity of 180 cow months which at present cannot be utilized by the Tribal Herd; and

WHEREAS for the value of the grazing privilege on this land, a grazing fee of 10¢ per head per month will be charged; and

WHEREAS the above grazing fee be deposited to the Tribal Herd IIM Account for payment to the King Investment Company for water used by Tribal livestock

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED: By the Papago Council that we authorize the Superintendent of the Sells Agency to issue an "OH and CFP" grazing permit to the King Investment Company pursuant to Section 16 of the General Grazing Regulations as approved by the Secretary of the Interior on December 28, 1935.

The foregoing Resolution was on this 3d day of April, 1943 duly enacted by the vote of 14 for, and 0 against by the Papago Council, under the provisions of Section 3, Article V, and Section 4, Article VIII, of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Papago Tribe.
