

RESOLUTION OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 300

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has, in its resolution setting up positions and making appointments of Tribal Employees, used the phrase: "Provided, that this appointee shall be allowed the same privileges with respect to annual and sick leaves as are allowed like employees of the Indian Service", or similar phraseology, and

WHEREAS, these provisos were inadvertently omitted from several resolutions, and in other cases may be construed as referring only to the particular appointee, rather than to any occupant of the position, and

WHEREAS, it has been the clear intent of the Papago Council that all Tribal Employees receive annual leave and sick leave privileges, and Tribal Employees have been taking such leaves regularly,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that all Tribal employees shall be allowed the same annual and sick leave privileges as are granted like employees of the Indian Service,

PROVIDED, that applications for such leaves shall be subject to prior approval by the Chairman of the Papago Council, or such person as he may designate, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, that leaves taken in good faith by the Tribal Employees heretofore is hereby approved and made valid, and salary payments made for such leaves are hereby validated, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, that all previous provisions to the contrary for leave and the approval of leave for Tribal Employees, are hereby superseded.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1946, duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council by a vote of 12 for and 0 against, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3(a), Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 964). The foregoing resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Indian Agency, subject to approval by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe.
