

RESOLUTION

THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 301

WHEREAS, The Tribal Rodeo corrals and chutes are badly in need of repairs and

WHEREAS, The Papago Fair and Rodeo Association has estimated a cost of about \$300.00 for such repairs;

THEREFORE it is resolved by the Papago Tribal Council that we authorize the expenditure of not to exceed \$300.00 from the IIM Account, No. PT-10, Livestock sales tax collections, to be used to make such repairs on the said corrals and chutes as may be necessary;

PROVIDED that such expenditures for repairs be under the direction and supervision of the rodeo committee and the Extension Agents.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1946, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for and 0 against by the Papago Tribal Council, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Sec. 3(a) Article V, of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe enacted by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). The foregoing resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Indian Agency.
