

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the application by the Board of National Missions of the Presbyterian Church in the U.S.A. for an assignment for mission purposes of an additional tract of land adjoining its present Presbyterian Church Tract in Sells Village has been approved by the Sells District Council,

THERFORE, be it resolved by the Papago Council that we approve said assignment, and hereby recommend to the Superintendent of Sells Agency that assignment to the Board of National Missions of the Presbyterian Church in the U.S.A. be made of the land in Sells Village bounded as follows:

Beginning at the pipe marking the SW corner of the present Sells Presbyterian Church Tract, 100.2 ft. S. 5° 25' E., hence 232.0 ft. easterly, hence 100.0 ft. N. 89° 30' E. to a point on the south line of the present Sells Presbyterian Church Tract 240.0 ft. easterly of the point of beginning, approximately 0.5 acres, as per attached plot plan.

PROVIDED, that this assignment be relinquished whenever it ceases to be used for mission purposes.

The foregoing Resolution was on Nov. 1, 1946, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against by the Papago Tribal Council, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (k), Article V, of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Jan. 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1943, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Indian Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
