

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Extra  
Permit

NO. 306

BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that a permit be granted Basil Hall Callahan to remove gusno from the tribal lands of the Papago Reservation, such permit to run for one year from the date of approval of this resolution, but to be cancelled should the permittee discontinue operations permanently.

PROVIDED, that no permit shall be granted any other person for this purpose so long as this permit is in force.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the permittee shall employ Papago labor exclusively, if available.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the permittee shall pay to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council \$10.00 for each ton of gusno removed.

PROVIDED FINALLY, that violation of the above provisions by the permittee shall void this permit.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 6, 1946, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (e), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
