

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council, Mrs. Suzanne I. Enos, is under the leave regulations approved by the Papago Council in Resolution #300, is going on Maternity Leave as of the close of business December 6, 1946, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Enos's leave extends until the close of business February 7, 1947 as of which date she is tendering her resignation as Secretary-Treasurer, and

WHEREAS, the business of the Papago Council must be transacted during this period of leave,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Mrs. Ida N. Wilson be appointed as Acting Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council as of December 2, 1946, and as Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council as of February 10, 1947, starting at a monthly salary of \$150.00 provided that any raises given the Secretary-Treasurer be approved by the Papago Council.

PROVIDED, that this appointee shall also serve as Acting Treasurer of the Papago Loan Board and as Manager of the Papago Arts and Crafts Board, and as Clerk of the Papago Court.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$450.00 be transferred from the Emergency Fund FT-7 to the Salaries of Tribal Employees FT-4 to cover the unforeseen cost of Mrs. Enos's leave not provided for in the regular budget for the Fiscal Year 1947.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 6, 1946, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), and Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Bells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
