NO. 309

RESOLVED, BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, that in consideration of the sum of \$1.00, paid to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council, the Papago Council grants a permit to the Government of the United States of America for transient use by Military Aircraft of the landing area of the Sells Airport,

PROVIDED, that the provisos of the Standard Contract between Owners of Non-Military Airports and the United States of America shall be binding upon both parties to this permit.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 6, 1946, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
