RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 311

WHEREAS, The cost of operation of the Tribal Office and the Tribal Community Building has been greater this year than anticipated, due to the increased cost of commodities and to the necessity of replenishing stocks of supplies unavailable during the war period, and

WHEREAS, The \$200.00 provided for this purpose in Fund, FT-3 Papago Tribe, Office Supplies and Expenses, in the 1947 Budget (Resolution No.288, dated May 3, 1946) has been spent,

THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Papago Council that the sum of \$150.00 be transferred from Fund PT-7, Papago Tribe, Exergency Fund to Fund, PT-3, Papago Tribe, Office Supplies and Expenses, to be used as provided in the Fiscal Year 1947 Budget under that section.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1947, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
